

Weed Abatement

Each year the Vallejo City Council sets a deadline for removal of weeds (May 1 was the weed removal deadline set by the Vallejo City Council last year). The council has declared that all weeds growing upon private or public property or streets in the city and all rubbish on such property or streets are public nuisances and are subject to abatement by eradication and/or removal under the provisions of Sections 7.56.060 through 7.56.140. This means the City can fine you and add the fine to your property tax bill. The Hiddenbrooke Property Owners Association, Inc. will also enforce the CC&Rs for weed abatement. Lots that have not been landscaped and maintained are also subject to enforcement actions under the CC&Rs. So please—for the safety of you and your neighbors—cut and remove your weeds so they are **no more than 3” high**.
